<p><b>Principal Report</b></p>	<p><b>Ms. Pfanmuller</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Updates on Covid-19</li> <li>School regulations</li> <li>• School Budget/Enrollment</li> <li>• Current Topics &amp; highlights</li> </ul>	<p>All items entering the school must be in isolation for a period of no less than 72 hours.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 7 schools in the NGPS district have/had at least 1 case of Covid-19 reported</li> <li>• No cases of Covid-19 in SCS as of yet.</li> <li>• Staff are no longer eating lunch together, the timetable will be slightly shifted to allow for non-communal eating.</li> <li>• Enrollment is up, Sangudo Community School now has 73 in person students, 11 online students, and 2 ADLC students.</li> <li>• The budget for the year will be in conjunction with the viability report which the board should decide on November 24, 2020.</li> <li>• Sangudo Community School, because of its small size, would need to be exempt from the “rule of funding” where a stipend is received for each child enrolled, and instead be seen as a stand alone and be funded as needed. Classes are split at every grade making the school as economically sound as can be.</li> <li>• Trickster has been cancelled until March 8-12. We are optimistic the residency will be in person or if need be virtually.</li> <li>• Singing in class is no longer allowed.</li> <li>• Lunch program nothing finalized right now, we may look into ordering from The Jaded Chef or from Sub-Way, so AHS food safety regulations are in place.</li> </ul>
