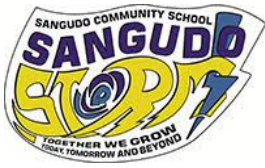
The spring Scholastic Book Fair is scheduled for the week of March 14-18, 2022. Watch for information regarding the book fair to come home soon.

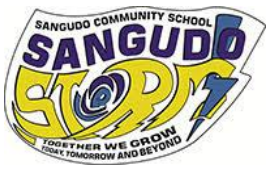

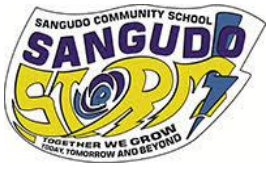
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## Sangudo Storm Sports Report

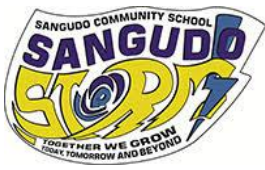
Every purchase made at the school or online will earn rewards for the school Scholastic money to purchase more books for the school library!

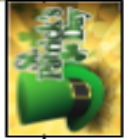
