- June 28, 2022: School awards ceremony and recognition, and grade 9 farewell

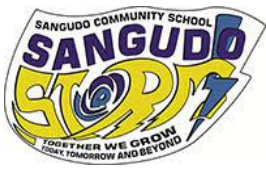
We are looking forward to the last few weeks of the 2021-2022 school year. Please review our website and follow us on social media to stay up to date with the coming events and activities.

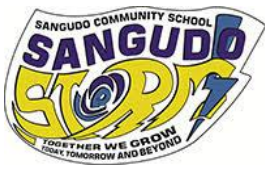
