Message from the Principal

It is hard to believe that two months of the school year have already passed! SCS has had an excellent and busy start to the 2022-2023 school year. Students participated in the annual Terry Fox Run around the Sangudo Community and the Lac Ste. Anne Fire Department volunteered to keep us safe during our run! Students also had the opportunity to participate in age appropriate Orange Shirt Day activities on September 29 to honor Indigenous children who were sent away to residential schools in Canada and learn more about the history of those schools.

On October 13 students in grades kindergarten through seven participated in presentations by Lac Ste Anne County Fire about fire prevention and safety. Students even got to go inside a fire truck and spray the fire hose! The Sangudo Community Foundation Fire Department then provided a wonderful BBQ lunch for all students and staff. Thank you to all!

Both the girls and boys volleyball teams have been doing wonderful and are winding up their season. We all look forward to watching their last few games!

Staff and students have been enjoying hot lunches prepared by our amazing volunteers. A huge thank you to PASS and our volunteers for supporting the hot lunch program at SCS.
