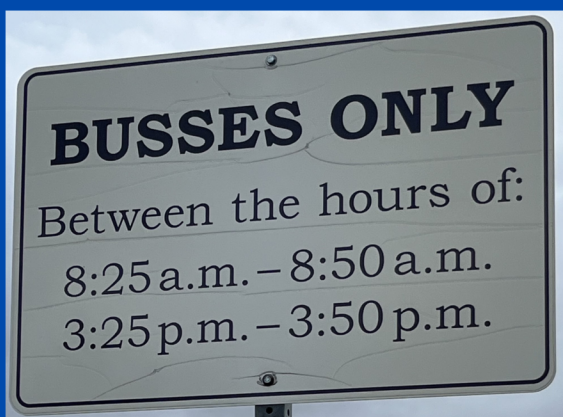
What a busy month April has been:

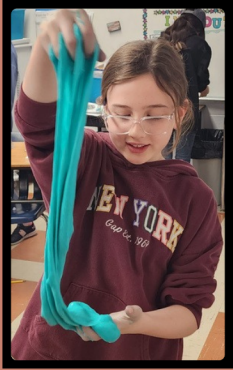

5TH & 6TH GRADE NEWS

THIS MONTH

This past month after spring break has flown by! We have been busy starting and completing our last few units in all subject areas. The grade 6 students are also beginning to prepare for writing their Provincial Achievement Tests in all core subject areas, starting with field testing for the Language Arts Part A (writing) and Math Part A (numerical response), in Mid-May. This past month in Language Arts, we started our final novel study for the year, *The Breadwinner* by Deborah Ellis. We have also been focusing on Opinion Writing. In Math, both grades finished up fractions and decimals, as well as, geometry: transformations. Next, they will be moving on to Measurement: Perimeter, Area & Volume.

SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES

Science:

- Grade 5: Finished up Classroom Chemistry with lots of fun experiments, including making slime, oobleck and rock candy! They are now beginning their final unit on Electricity & Magnetism.
- Grade 6: Finished up their Evidence & Investigation unit and will soon be participating in solving crimes within the school, using the knowledge they have gained throughout the unit. They have just begun their final unit on Flight and Air & Aerodynamics.

Social Studies:

- Grade 5: Continuing exploring the history and stories of Canada, including the Fur Trade, New France, Loyalists, British North America, Westward Expansion, and immigrants.
- Grade 6: Finished up their study on the local and provincial government and have begun learning about Ancient Athens and where democracy began!

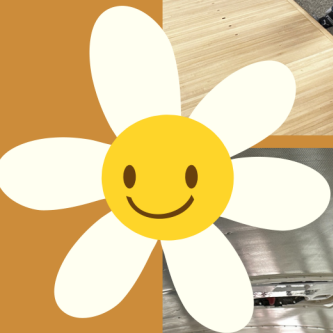

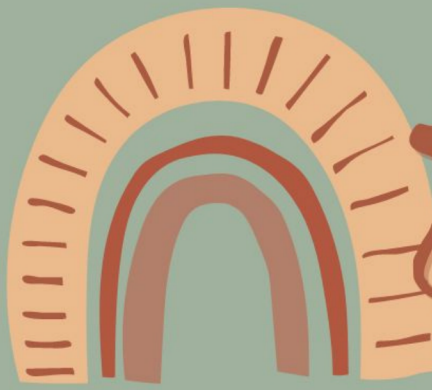


Field Trip Fun

In Language Arts, we are working on descriptive setting writing with a focus on adjectives and synonyms.

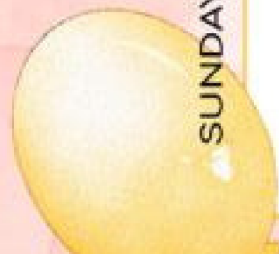
