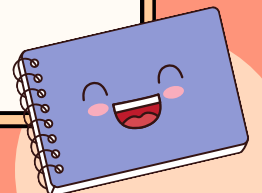
Grade 5 Classroom News

January 2025

In Language Arts, we've been working hard to finish our Wonder novel study. We've also been working on morphology, where students add prefixes and suffixes to words to create new words. In math, students completed multiplication and division of whole numbers using a variety of strategies, and we've moved on to data and graphing analysis. In science, students learned about the digestive and skeletal systems in humans, and we'll soon be moving on to the muscular and nervous systems. In social studies, students completed a group project on different Jobs in Ancient Egypt and are now studying Ancient Greece and life in that time period.

We finished our government unit and will be learning about Ancient Athens and Rome.

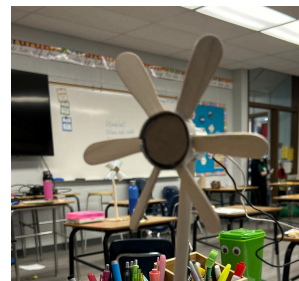
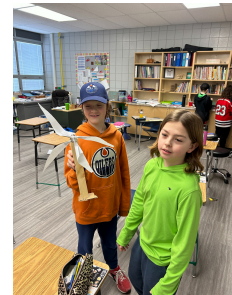
Science
