The annual Eastlink ski trip was on February 21 and what a great turnout, with 80 students from Grades 2-9 going.

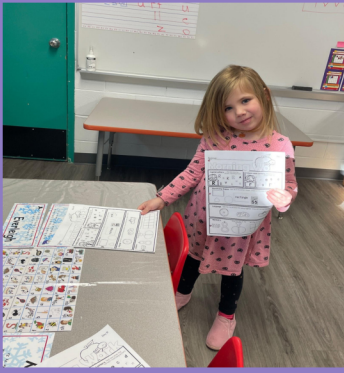

Here's hoping that we only have a few more weeks of winter as we head into March and an early Spring. As always feel free to continue to contact me with any questions or concerns

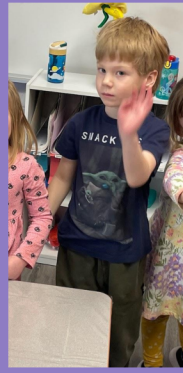

In Science we finished our energy unit and have moved onto Earth Systems. Social has been full of Ancient Athens and how democracy started many years ago.

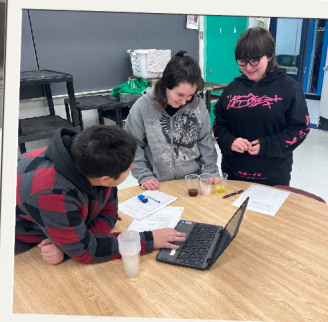
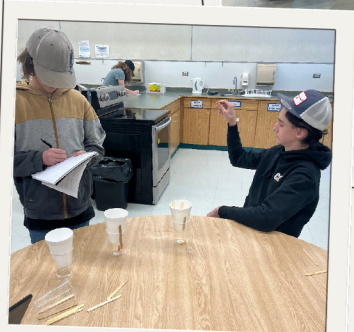
