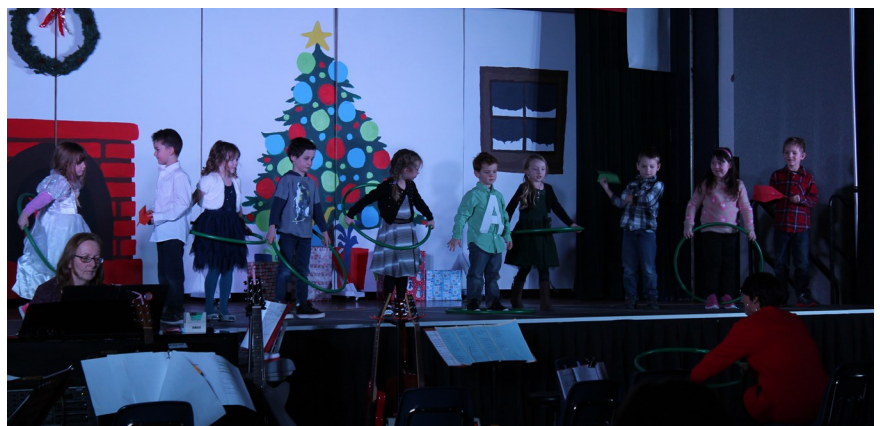

School-Wide Reading Challenge!

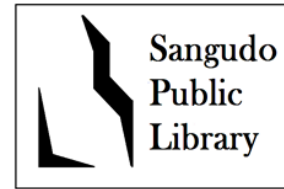
